The HASANZ Register is a national, online database to help businesses find qualified workplace health and safety professionals. Everyone listed on the HASANZ Register must belong to a HASANZ member association and meet required competency standards, so businesses can have confidence in their advice and services. There's a charge to list on the register but it's free to use.

The HASANZ Register opens for business later in 2017.

The development of the HASANZ Register is funded by ACC and WorkSafe New Zealand.

Welcome to the first edition of Register that! HASANZ has created this newsletter to communicate directly with you to prepare for the launch of the HASANZ Register later this year. It's exciting to see the HASANZ Register taking shape.

Wellington-based company Signify was appointed as the project's software developer in May and we're now working hard on designing the Register. We were impressed by Signify's ability to put themselves in users' shoes and are confident they will deliver a really user-friendly product.

Meanwhile, our HASANZ member associations are busy determining the competency standards their members will have to meet when applying to list on the Register. The HASANZ Leadership Team has agreed a common set of Registration Standards requirements that cover qualifications, experience, CPD, ethics, good character and insurance. Each member association's registration standards must be approved by the HASANZ Leadership Team to help ensure consistency of professional standards across different areas of practice. Associations will advise their members when their specific registration standards are available to view – ETA is end of July.
